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1. Purpose

The purpose of this document is to define ISMS objectives which need to be met. The achievability of these objectives would be measured through the Key Performance Indicators (KPIs).

2. Scope

The scope of this document covers the ISO 27001:2013 Implementation covering ICT Department.

3. ISMS Objective Criteria

The information security objectives shall:

- be consistent with the information security policy;
- be measurable (if practicable);
- take into account applicable information security requirements, and results from risk assessment and risk treatment;
- be communicated; and
- Be updated as appropriate.

4. ISMS Objective

- To identify the information assets, to understand their vulnerabilities and threats that may expose them to risk, through appropriate risk management.
- To manage the identified risk to an acceptable level through the design, implementation, and maintenance of a formal Information Security Management System.
- To comply with applicable laws and regulations pertaining to information security, be it for its own data or customer data held by KGiS Services.
- To raise awareness of information security risks and security awareness.
- To implement mechanisms to ensure that all breaches of information security and suspected weaknesses are reported and investigated followed by adequate action
- To ensure minimal interruption to business services by protecting the application and network infrastructure of KGiS ICT Department.
